Day of Atonement The most important holy day for the Israelites, also called Yom Kippur (from Hebrew yohm hak·kip·pu·rim', "day of the coverings"), held on Ethanim 10. This was the only day of the year on which the high priest went into the Most Holy of the tabernacle and later of the temple.

The Day of Atonement was designed to deal with all these realities. Most of the procedures followed on the Day of Atonement were similar to those followed for the other offerings except that the blood of the sacrifices was sprinkled on the mercy seat in the Most Holy Place as well (Lev. 16:14).

Yom Kippur - Day of Atonement - Hebrew for Christians

The "Day of Atonement" is the English phrase for Yom Kippur. The shresh [root] for the word "Kippur" is kafar (כַּפַּר), which probably derives from the word kofer, meaning "ransom." This word is parallel to the word "redeem" (Psalm 49:7) and means "to atone by offering a substitute."
