The core multi-lateral intellectual property conventions (the Berne and Paris conventions) have long enshrined the principle of national treatment in international intellectual property law. This is the principal that (with certain treaty-defined exceptions) nations party to the convention are required to accord to the citizens of other parties the same rights to copyright and industrial property that they accord to their own citizens.
