Popper makes a clear distinction between subjective and objective knowledge. The former is connected to belief, and strives to achieve complete certitude, because the more firmly we believe in our expectations the more secure we are. Subjective knowledge is ultimate based on the testimony of our senses.

World1 is the world of physical objects; World2 is the world of our subjective beliefs, thoughts, feelings; World3 is what he calls an objective world of knowledge, the objective contents of thought--the knowledge contained in books, museums, libraries, etc. Popper holds that most philosophers considered the object of epistemology--the theory of knowledge--to be World2. Popper argues that this is misguided.

How Karl Popper Has Made a Difference in Our Lives

Guided by his belief that the academic owes the public a lucid style, Popper crisply argues for realism, fallibilism, and verisimilitude in Objective Knowledge, a compilation of essays first published in 1972. Essay by essay, the philosopher charts the conditions for the growth of scientific or objective knowledge, which he frames as a peculiarly human invention akin to the spider's web.

He had public debates with Ernst Bloch and Theodor Adorno, two of the most popular luminaries of Continental philosophy in the 1950s and 1960s, and in 1972 he published his third major book, Objective knowledge, in which he established a close link between his philosophy of science and the development of neo-Darwinism. In Objective Knowledge, Karl Popper proposes a defense of freewill on the bases of the Theory of Three Worlds and Evolutionary Epistemology. Contrary to Popper's
