South Africa is a party to the Biological and Toxin Weapons Convention (BTWC), and is not currently believed to have a biological weapons program. However, the country had an extensive apartheid-era biological weapons program. Beginning in 1981 under the South African Defense Force's Project Coast, the program was dismantled in 1993 by order of President F.W. de Klerk.
